

### Visa

If you are not an EU/EEA citizen, you may require a visa to come to the UK. ### Travel information

Winchester is only 1 hour by train from London, but for participants arriving from the main Heathrow airport it is easiest to take a coach which takes ~1 hour and can be booked in advance from:

Alternatively one can take the railair coach to Woking and then catch the train to Winchester. Train times can be found at:

From Gatwick airport, it is simplest to get the train to Clapham Junction and then change to Winchester (journey time ~2.5 hours), or one can take a National Express coach and change at Heathrow for a similar journey time.

Much closer to Winchester, Southampton airport is an international airport with direct flights from many destinations across Europe (mainly served by [Flybe](#)), and it only takes 10 minutes to reach Winchester by train. For a map of the destinations, check:
